

POTTED PLANTS

SUCCESS = 6 x S

SUCCESS IN 6 EASY S's

SUN -

Pay attention to sun exposure in each location to select appropriate plants.

SOIL -

Only mix plants in a vessel that like the same kind of soil.

SPREAD-

Consider how much room your plant wants to grow. Plan for the growth, not just how it looks today.

SEASON-

Mix annuals and perennials to have something to look at even when the seasons change, or re-plant every season for a fresh look. Just know what you're choosing.

SIZE -

Arrange the plants in a cascade - the large plants to the back or center and the smaller in the front or edges.

SATURATION-

Plants in the same pot need to like the same amount of water to thrive.



Keeping those flowers looking beautiful in pots is not always easy, but nothing makes a bigger statement than the color that comes from plants around your house and in your yard. These principles give you a formula to succeed in planting, and keeping alive, the plants you love. Mixing the right plants together can give you the look you have always wanted. Indoors and outside, with desert plants or lush flowers the principles are the same!
